

Over 500 poor families receive homes, farmland in Stung Treng

Synopsis: More households gain housing and three-hectare plots as the government expands a rural land allocation programme.

An additional 538 poor families will receive houses and three-hectare land plots under the government's forest protection land allocation programme to improve rural livelihoods and strengthen forest conservation.

The recipients were selected through a nationwide lottery held on July 27 by the Secretariat of the National Committee for the Implementation of the Forest Protection Land Allocation Programme for Sustainable Development.

The draw, broadcast live on National Television of Cambodia, allocated land plots and houses to eligible families under the programme's first project in Sdao and Samkhuoy communes, Sesan

district, Stung Treng province.

Initiated by Prime Minister Hun Manet, the programme aims to provide land to landless families, prevent illegal occupation of state land and encourage communities to protect forests through sustainable development.

The 538 families will resettle in the O'Sev 3 area, where each family receives ownership of a house and three hectares of farmland under the government's social land concession programme for cultivation and income generation.

Sar Sovann, Minister Delegate attached to the Prime Minister and Permanent Vice-Chairman of the National Committee, said the government has invested in infrastructure to ensure beneficiaries can establish sustainable livelihoods.

The development includes 125 kilometres of main and secondary

roads, 30 reservoirs, and 770 housing units, of which 751 have been completed.

According to the committee, 12,329 families nationwide applied for land between February and March 2025. Following lottery draws and field verification, 497 families were selected for resettlement under the first phase of the

project in Stung Treng province.

Including other eligible beneficiaries, the first phase covers 755 families. Of these, 217 families had received land and houses through previous lottery draws, while the remaining 538 families secured their plots during July 27 draw.

The lottery took place in the presence of representatives from the

Prime Minister's Cabinet, the Anti-Corruption Unit, provincial governors and deputy governors from all 25 capital and provincial administrations, Buddhist clergy and civil society organisations.

Officials displayed all 538 ballots – representing land plot and house numbers 263 to 800 – before placing them into transparent rotating ballot drums for the draw.

Following the lottery, the secretariat handed provincial administrations the official lists of beneficiaries, allocated plot and house numbers, and site maps to notify successful applicants. The committee said authorities will invite beneficiaries to relocate to the new settlement and sign agreements to receive their houses and farmland.

It added that the next phase of the programme will focus on establishing an official village, constructing schools, a health post and a community market, while providing vocational training, improving market access, attracting investment and supporting residents. ■

The Government of the Kingdom of Cambodia has received a Loan from the Export-Import Bank of Korea from the resources of the Economic Development Cooperation Fund (EDCF) of the Republic of Korea in the amount of USD 97,223,000 (Ninety-Seven Million Two Hundred and Twenty-Three Thousand US Dollars) toward the cost of the Green Siem Reap Sewerage and Storm Drainage System Project and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the contract for construction of New Wastewater Treatment Plants, Sanitary Sewer Network and Storm Drainage System (Contract No. GSRSD-CW-01).
2. The Project Executing Agency, Ministry of Public Works and Transport (MPWT), now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Construction of a Wastewater Treatment Plant, Sanitary Sewer Network and Storm Drainage System in Siem Reap City, Siem Reap Province located in northwestern of Cambodia and is about 300 kilometers northwest of Phnom Penh, the capital of Cambodia.
3. Bidding will be conducted through Competitive Bidding (CB) procedures specified in the Guideline for Procurement under EDCF Loans, and is open to all eligible bidders that meet the following minimum qualification criteria:
 - 1) Nationals of the Republic of Korea or juridical person incorporated and registered therein;
 - 2) Minimum average annual construction turnover of US\$52 million within the last three (3) years (2023, 2024 and 2025);
 - 3) Experience in at least two (2) contracts of similar size and nature as contractor, management contractor, or JV partner, within the last ten (10) years (specifically from 2016 to the date of the bid invitation), each with a value of at least US\$30 million that have been successfully or are substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed works. The above contracts shall individually demonstrate experience in the following components: 1) At least one (1) contract of new construction or expansion of wastewater treatment plant with capacity of at least 6,000 m³/day; 2) At least one (1) contract of installation or replacement of sewer pipelines of at least 20 km under a single contract (excluding household connection). Each component shall be demonstrated by a separate contract. A single contract shall not be used to satisfy more than one; and
 - 4) Experience in key activities within the last ten (10) years (specifically from 2016 to the date of the bid invitation):
New installation of storm drainage lines in public works: longer than 8.7 km.
