- 1. The Government of the Republic of the Philippines has received a Loan from the Export-Import Bank of Korea from the resources of the Economic Development Cooperation Fund (EDCF) of the Republic of Korea in the amount of One Hundred Seventy-Two Million Six Hundred Forty-One Thousand Dollars (US\$172,641,000.00) toward the cost of New Cebu International Container Port Project and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the Contract No. DOTr-NCICPP-CW-001.
- 2. There will be two separate bidding processes for the project: one for the Detailed Design and Civil Works and the other for the procurement of Cargo Handling Equipment (4 quay cranes). This bid is for the Detailed Design and Civil Works of the New Cebu International Container Port, and the Employer intends to apply the amount of **One Hundred Eighteen Million Nineteen Thousand Dollars (US\$118,019,000.00)** of the Loan Proceeds to payment under the contract for this bid.
- 3. The Agency Cost Estimate is in the amount of **One Hundred Seventeen Million Nine Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Dollars (US\$117,924,000.00) inclusive of all duties and taxes**.
- 4. The Department of Transportation ("the Employer") now invites sealed bids from prequalified eligible Bidders for the construction and completion of New Cebu International Container Port Project.
- 5. Bidding will be conducted through Competitive Bidding (CB) procedures specified in the Guidelines for Procurement under EDCF Loans.

Authenticated copies of the aforesaid

documents shall be submitted to the Accounting Division through mail or other similar means. Please be advised that for bank-deposit transaction, Accounting Division shall only furnish the bidder with a copy of an Acknowledgment Receipt with Control Number recognizing the deposit made for the payment instead of an Official Receipt (OR) within five (5) working days from receipt of the required documents.

8. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 20 May 2022 9:00AM (Manila local time) (BDS 22.1). All bids must be accompanied by a bid security of Two Million Dollars (US\$2,000,000.00) (BDS 19.1). Late bids shall be rejected.
